PERMITEE AND OWNER AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Owner consents to the entry by Permittee upon the Property for the period specified above, and for the purpose described above (and no other purpose) and subject to the terms and conditions set forth below. This permit ends on the date set forth above. Owner may terminate this permit at any earlier time by mailing or delivering a notice of termination to the Permittee at the address shown below. Any use of Owner's Property contrary to the provisions of this agreement is unlawful and not permitted. Permittee agrees to indemnify, defend, and save harmless Owner and its agents and invitees from all claims, losses, injuries, liabilities, causes of action, damages, costs and expenses arising in any way from Permittee's entry onto the Property including, without limitation, injury or damage to Permittee and Permittee's property. This permit allows solely the Permittee named above to enter the Property and no one else. Owner makes no representations regarding the Property. Permittee will enter and use the Property at Permittee's sole risk. Permittee releases Owner from all claims, losses, injuries, liabilities, causes of action, damages, costs and expenses related to this permit and/or in connection with any use of the property by Permittee.

PERMITEE ALSO AGREES TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS, RESTRICTION AND CONDITIONS:

1. Fee: NONE
2. I will not remove any materials (including timber) from the Property. I will not injure Owner's trees.
3. I will not start any fires. I will not smoke.
4. I will not use any motor vehicles on the Property. I will not block any roads.
5. This permit may allow access to property where current logging, road construction, rock quarrying, or other hazardous activities are taking place. I agree to avoid the immediate area of any such operations and to protect myself and others from harm.
6. I will cooperate with officers of the law, Owner, Owner's agent, and other users of the Property. I will have a copy of this permit with me to show upon request.
7. I will promptly inform Owner if I observe any illegal activity or other irregularity.
8. I will not commit any waste of the Property. I will use the Property only during the day (sunrise to sunset) and will not camp overnight.
9. I will not interfere in any way with any use of the Property by Owner or its agents, invitees, licensees, or contractors.
10. I acknowledge that I have no right to use the Property except as expressly stated in the permit.
11. I will remove from the Property all items I bring on to the Property so that there will be no trace of my entry.
12. I acknowledge that no hunting is permitted. I will not bring any guns or other weapons onto the Property.

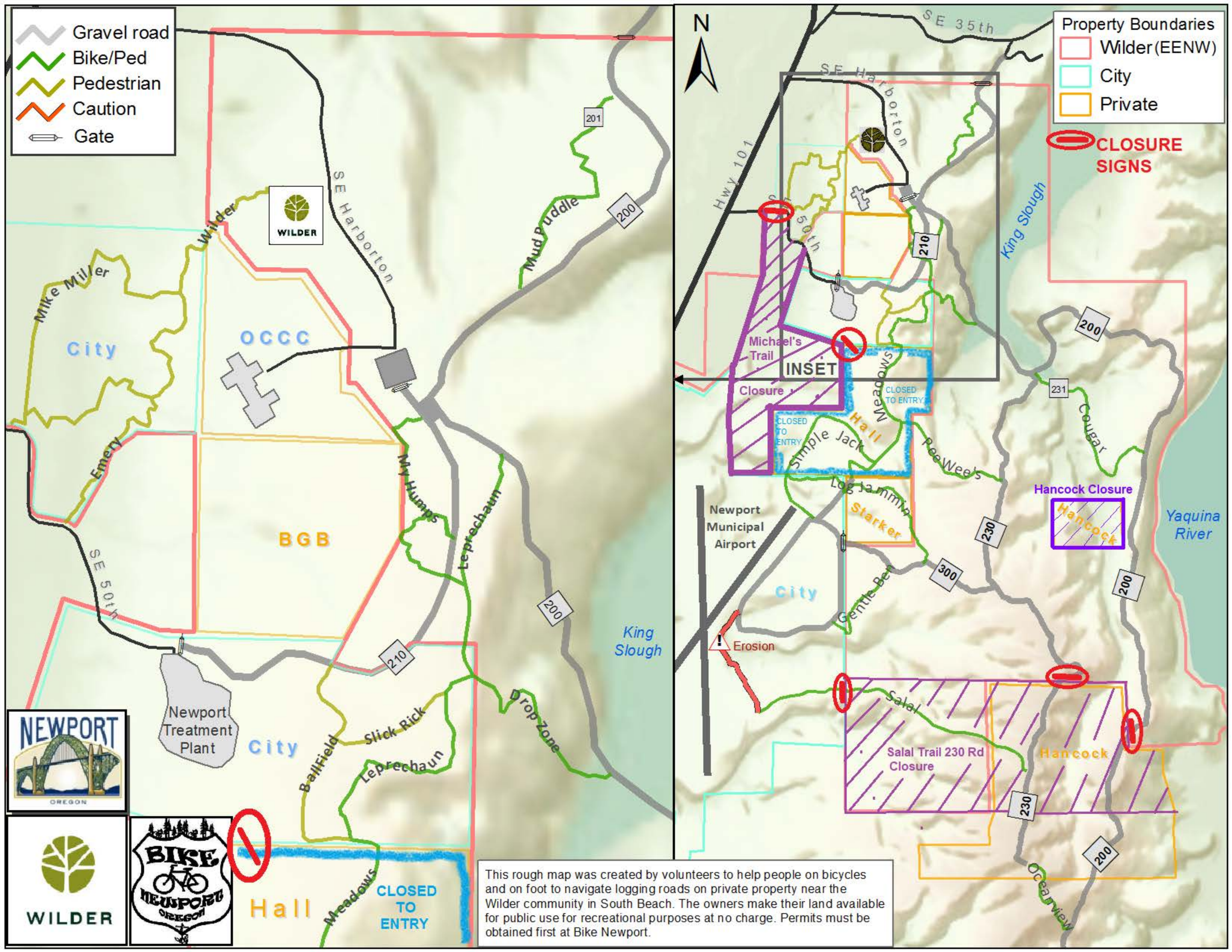
